- I. **Call to Order** Margaret Moroff called the meeting to order at 9:30 in the hearing room. She reminded everyone that the meeting is being recorded.
- II. Acceptance of Prior Minutes The board voted to table the minutes from 3/20/2025
- III. FY 2024 Budget Krista Celia presented the financial report for March 31, 2025
  - 1. Town Budget Balance: Salary: \$8,603, Town Funded Accounts: \$2,141.20
  - Formula Grant: \$18,654.73
    Program Donations: \$11,481.95
  - 4. General Donations: \$5,007.39
- **IV. Events** The board discussed the following upcoming events
  - a. Brown Bag and the Blood Pressure Clinic will be held Wednesday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>. Participation continues to grown and there are 38 participants currently signed up.
  - b. Singo will be held on May 7th at 12:30. This program has 27 people signed up to attend. The fee to run Singo is \$150 and the board agreed to continue offering this program.
  - c. Painting with Amy is scheduled for May 8<sup>th</sup> at 2:45. Amy's painting classes have been well attended. The last class had 20 participants.
  - d. Lunch and Learn with Bristol Aging and Wellness presented by Dawn Demarco. The program will be Nutrition Jeopardy and will be held on 05/04/25 at 12:00. There are 44 people signed up to attend.
  - e. Cultural Council grant recipient Jumpin Juba will perform at the Friend's luncheon on May 21<sup>st</sup>. The lunch will be hot dogs, coleslaw, and beans.
  - f. Men's Group The men's group has been scheduled for May 28<sup>th</sup> and June 25<sup>th</sup>. There were only 4 participants at the last meeting of the men's group. The June 25<sup>th</sup> meeting will feature a presentation about the Normandy invasion through present day photographs.
  - g. AED Defibrillator Training with Liza Amaral will be held on May 29th at 10:00.
  - h. Water Color Painting is scheduled for June 5<sup>th</sup> at 9:00.
