

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
BERKLEY BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Pursuant to Article 1, Section 2, of the General Bylaws of the Town of Berkley, the Board of Selectmen will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, May 21, 2025, at 6:55 p.m.** in the Moitoza-Petty Hearing Room at Town Hall, One North Main Street, Berkley, Massachusetts, regarding proposed amendments to the General Bylaws as follows:

A new proposed bylaw, titled “**Berkley Noise Law,**” was submitted in writing by ten or more registered voters of the Town. The petition seeks to adopt the proposed “Berkley Noise Law,” which establishes limits on excessive, continuous, or plainly audible noise originating from both stationary and mobile sources within the Town. The bylaw outlines specific prohibited acts, including sustained noise from amplified sound systems and certain motor vehicles, and provides for exemptions (e.g., agriculture, construction, municipal events). Violations are subject to enforcement by the Select Board or Police Department and may incur escalating fines. The complete text of the proposed bylaw is on file and available for public review at the office of the Town Clerk.

You are invited to attend the public hearing and participate in the discussion. Any person wishing to be heard should appear at the place and time designated. Comments may also be submitted in writing to the Board of Selectmen prior to the hearing through mail or email at selectmen@berkleyma.us
