Old Business

- The board reviewed the notice of right of first refusal 16.84 acres at 137 Bayview Ave.

Motion to not exercise the Towns right of first refusal made by Pontes, Cochrane sec. – Voted

The Board reviewed the final numbering of the Annual Town Meeting Warrant articles. Miller explained articles three and four regarding the Highway Surveyor/Tree Warden and changing the position to appointed. Miller feels that it would be beneficial to the Town to be sure that the position does not become a voting by popularity contest. The Town Administrator touched on the ballot questions and spoke about the potential bylaw changes. He also noted that we need to have a bylaw hearing. The Town Administrator suggested having it at the May 2, 2018 Selectmen's Meeting. The Board agreed. Miller wanted to know if counsel got back to them yet on the possibility of adding an explanation on the warrant articles. Mr. Coutinho stated that you cannot say things like "A 'Yes' vote would be beneficial to the Town" however you could say that "A 'Yes' vote would change it from elected to appointed" and the same thing goes for the override. Both Miller and the Town Administrator agreed that they would hate to add an explanation and it give reason for a challenge after the vote.

New Business

- The Board reviewed an application for a special permit in the general business district from BayCoast Bank. The BayCoast bank needs a variance for the drive-thru window. It is required that they send the plans to several Boards. Miller stated that he has been on board for some time with Mr. Jackson as well as the Planning Board and he is in full support. Miller stated that it would be nice if the Town could switch some of their business over to their bank.

- The Board received a memo and permit from the Dept. of the Army Engineers regarding boat ramp. Miller would like to take another look at the initial agreement that they signed to be sure that they still want to be bound to those agreements.

Soil Board

Request for clarification from MBL Land Development and Permitting Corp for determination if a soil board permit is required for the proposed BayCoast Bank at 2 Locust Street. Mr. Coutinho believes that there is no need for a permit because it is a new construction. Miller asked the Town Administrator to look into the bylaw for the Board. Miller asked Mr. Coutinho to check with counsel if there are certain questions that we should ask. Miller suggested the Town charge the fee if there needs to be an analysis. Town Administrator noted that according to the Soil Board Rules & Regs it states that there is no need for a permit for new construction unless there is a change in elevation by two feet. Miller would like to have Town Administrator look at a TOPO and give his opinion.
