

**FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

We are "kicking off" our Fiscal Budget Season of 2021 and Chairman Joe Freitas indicated that on February 24, 2020, fact finding begins with the K-8 Berkley system and to please review, research, prepare questions that we may have to help the committee as a whole to work out a budget that can work for the schools as well as the Berkley community.


Listed below are some of the topics brought up to review;

- The DLS Preliminary Cherry sheets were in our packets for both Somerset/Berkley High School and the Berkley K-8.
- School asking for 3.710% and this does not include high ticket items that need to be considered.
- School sending concerns.
- Capital improvements and funding.

Other Business.

A request was made by Chairman Joe Freitas to send a response to the email received by Charlene of the Planning Board and a letter inviting the Superintendent Tom Lynch.

Discussion on OSHA and the need to invite them to come and do a walk through inspection of our public buildings/areas. Right now this option is free and in the future it will cost the town.

A motion was made and seconded to approve (roughly \$16,000.00) for Fire Station 2 well system. Unanimously voted for approval by the committee.
