

Call To Order	Board of Selectmen - Called to Order at 2:30PM remotely via ZOOM	
New Business:	<p>Board to consider and potentially vote to terminate or consider setting an end date/time on the Local State of Emergency; review of matter; votes may be taken</p> <p>The Board of Selectmen convened in emergency session on Wednesday, February 25, 2026 to review snow removal efforts, the reopening of municipal buildings, and potential continued school closures.</p> <p>Selectwoman Tabitha McCrohan recommended extending the local state of emergency through the late afternoon of Friday, noting the importance of not constraining school district decision-making.</p> <p>Selectman Horsfall concurred and emphasized the need for clear communication with the school district.</p> <p>With Chair Jennifer Vincent absent, the Selectmen present voted to terminate the local state of emergency effective 5:00 PM on Friday, February 27, 2026.</p>	<p>MH moved; TM seconded; motion approved</p>


