What is OPEB?

Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) are benefits provided to employees after retirement that are **not pensions**. These typically include **retiree health insurance and related benefits**. The OPEB Trust is established to responsibly fund these future obligations and to ensure the long-term financial stability of retiree benefits.

About the OPEB Board of Trustees

The OPEB Board of Trustees oversees the administration and investment of OPEB trust funds. Trustees play an important role in:

- Reviewing and monitoring the financial health of the OPEB Trust
- Working with investment and actuarial professionals
- Helping ensure that retiree benefits are managed prudently and transparently

This is an excellent opportunity for AFSCME, STA members and Somerset and Berkley residents to have a voice in decisions that directly impact current employees and future retirees.

The Board of Trustees typically meets only a few times per year via Zoom and meetings are usually about one hour or less.
