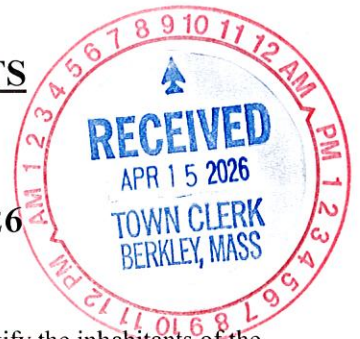

QUESTION:


